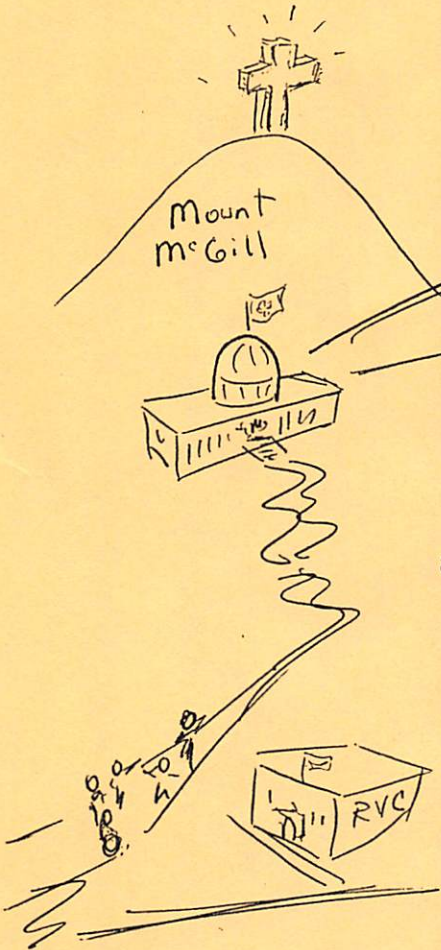

from a simple dream.

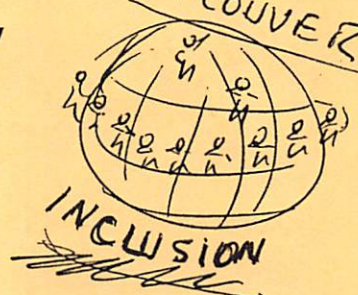
it was never easy on mount mcgill

so time to end with integrity...



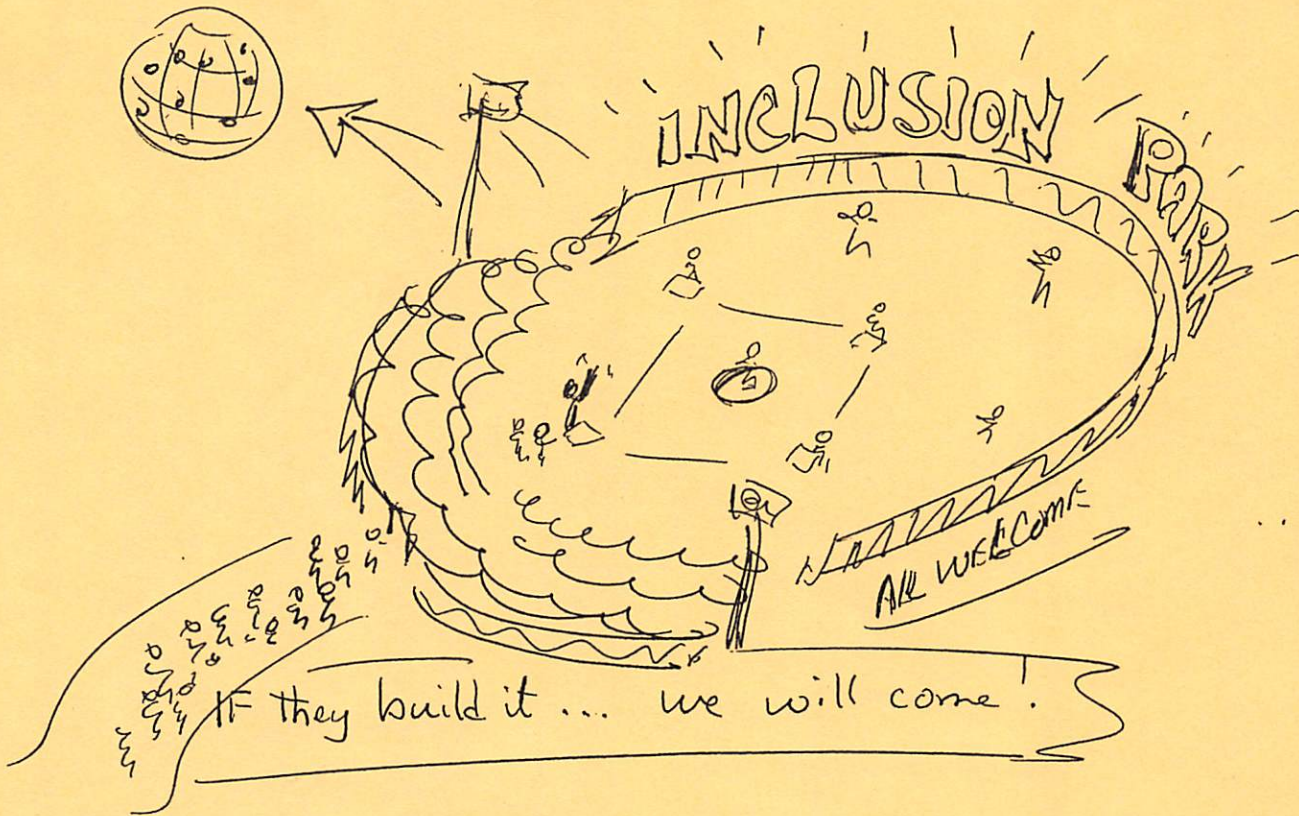




mcgill may be over but we all move ahead
