"Like all great art, Facilitation has deep roots in our intrinsic need to be connected, seen and encouraged. We continue to be curious about, and deeply in love with the idea, that we can be listening, and suddenly hit with a thought, "That's interesting!". And then ask ourselves, "How do we hold the space for something to happen here, and then have the wisdom to wait to see what happens?"

In 2018 and 2019, you've partnered with the Family Support Institute of British Columbia, to see if it was possible to level the playing field with regards to families and other people who have limited access to good person centered process facilitation, because of their geographic location in British Columbia.

So we supported over 100 people across British Columbia to learn the ins and outs of Person Centered work, how to facilitate a PATH and the principles of a culture of gentleness.

We witnessed time and again the power of working in person centered ways using the principles of a culture of gentleness, and Gentle Teaching, and how it shifted people's work, play and lives. Indeed, it is precisely what happened to us. Interestingly, we began, and continue to learn the ways that good facilitation shows up everywhere in our lives.

So we want you to come and learn about what we discovered while working in a deeply facilitative way, and how it has helped us to survive and thrive during the pandemic, helped us to open new and exciting conversations across two hemispheres, three continents, and in our own backyard, and with each other."
