Gabbitude's Tips & Helpful Hints

- Take 10 minutes a day and just explore whatever app and device you are using. Practice makes a pattern!
- Create your own graphic recording brush palette with a couple different brush styles to show variety (brushes for titles, headings, body, people, icons, shading, etc.).
- Make your own color palette! Make sure to include different colors for titles, headings, body text, shading, icons, and razzle dazzle.
- Don't forget to PREP! The more you can do on the front end, the better!
- Practice your handwriting and drawing icons! Pinterest and Google are your friend in helping to find inspiration and practice sheets.
- Create your own font! My favorite app is the web-based Calligraphr program: https://www.calligraphr.com/en/
